Reflections on the Sunday Scripture

June 11, 2017

The Most Holy Trinity

Readings: Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9 2 Corinthians 13:11-13
John 3:16-18

Gospel

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

1. When you consider the Holy Trinity, how does it affect your understanding of your Faith, your beliefs, and how you worship?
2. At the heart of the Trinity is God's love, expressed in its fullness. How do you see and feel God's love for you? Think about the words "He *gave* his only Son," as compared to "He *sent*." Yes, there is a difference.
3. Do you realize that you have already been made part of the love of the Holy Trinity? Do you know how, why, and when? *Hint: You were probably an infant and dressed in white.*
4. Many of us are always trying to reason with and understand the Holy Trinity, and sometimes it causes us to question our faith. How about meditating on how the Trinity affects us? Do we appreciate that profound love of God? Do you feel the unity?
5. When you receive the Eucharist, do you also feel the love of God and the Holy Spirit?

Note: Meditate this week on the Most Holy Trinity; the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and see what happens.



Next Sunday, June 18, the Feast of *Corpus Christi* (*The Body and Blood of Christ*) will be celebrated at the 10 AM Mass.

This Feast dates back to the Middle Ages and became a Feast in 1312. It parallels The Last Supper on Holy Thursday, but it is more a joyous celebration and one of thanksgiving, as Christ's prophecies of His death, resurrection and ascension into heaven have been fulfilled. He also sent the Holy Spirit to His disciples, and the Holy Trinity was revealed to mankind - all as He promised.



The official title of this Solemnity was changed in 1970 to **The Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi.)**

A procession with the Holy Eucharist often takes place, even in Anglo-Catholic services. The Host is placed in a monstrance. The priest, facing the congregation, elevates the monstrance and, while holding it under a canopy, proceeds with it, followed by the congregation in solemn procession, outside and around the church, stopping at four altars for prayers, song, and readings from the Gospels. Once the outside procession has gone around ... and back ... the assembly returns to the church for Benediction.



We invite all to join us for our celebration of the "*The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*" as we honor Corpus Christi during our Mass and Procession, on Sunday, June 18 at the 10 AM Mass.

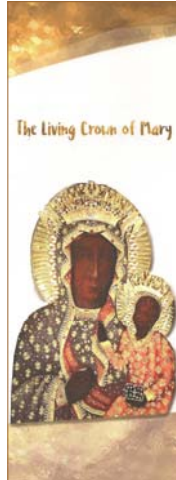
